EL PAST SIMPLE YA LO ESTUVIMOS TRABAJANDO CON EJERCICIOS, TEXTOS Y RESÚMENES. EN ESTE CASO VAMOS A TRABAJAR CON PAST CONTINUOUS.

PAST CONTINUOUS

SE UTILIZA PARA DESCRIBIR ACCIONES EN PROGRESO EN EL PASADO. POR EJEMPLO, CUANDO DECIMOS: "ESTABA ESTUDIANDO." "ESTÁBAMOS MIRANDO LA TELE, ETC.

ESTE TIEMPO SE FORMA CON EL VERBO ESTAR =WAS/ WERE + EL OTRO VERBO CON ING (ANDO / ENDO). EXAMPLES:

- ADRIAN HELMSKY **WAS WORKING** IN INDIA
- PEOPLE **WERE LIVING** NORMAL LIVES...
- JACKSON CURTIS **WAS CAMPING**...

COMO VERÁN, ES IMPORTANTE SABER CUÁNDO USO WAS Y CUÁNDO WERE (ESE RESÚMEN ERA UNO DE LOS TRABAJOS DEL PRIMER TRIMESTRE)

PARA NEGAR, SÓLO PONGO NOT DETRÁS DE WAS /WERE. EXAMPLES:

- SHE **WAS NOT (=WASN'T)** LOOKING WHEN THE ACCIDENT HAPPENED.
- THE POLICEMEN **WERE NOT (WEREN'T)** USING THEIR GUNS.

SI QUIERO HACER UNA PREGUNTA EN ESTE TIEMPO, PASO WAS /WERE DELANTE DE LA PERSONA.

- **WERE YOU DRIVING** FAST?
- WHAT **WAS YOUR DAD DOING**?
