TOURISTS AND TRAVELERS

Most of us agree that a tourist is not the same as a traveler; but both have somethings in common. For example, if their **destination** is far away, both the tourist and the traveler may well prefer to fly. There are differences between the two types of person when they arrive at their destination.

The tourist may tend to rush around trying to see, and take photos of places, as much as possible before leaving for the next place on the list. Other tourists, **head for** the beach, leaving it only to take a quick **trip** to the nearest shopping centre or local **crafts market**. In the evenings, they prefer eat in a restaurant or drink in a bar till the small hours.

In contrast, typical travelers tend to **take things at a slower pace**. Their aim is to get to know as much as possible about the culture and customs of the region. Local **means of transportation** are often preferred, even if this involves riding on a donkey or a camel. Sometimes, travelers simply prefer to see region **on foot**. They are often attracted by deserts and **jungles**, despite all the minor **discomforts**- lack of fresh water, insect bites, snakes, dangerous animals, cholera- that they might suffer in those places. So what's it to be? Are you a tourist or Are you a traveler?
